VACATION RENTAL CLEANING GUIDELINES

Be aware of any damage, missing items, size discrepancy or excessively dirty homes as these need to be reported immediately. The stock levels on dish soap, body wash, shampoo, conditioner paper towels, and toilet paper should always be reported if its running low.
